Alternative 7. (NEW) (PREFERRED) Establish an aggregate bag limit of 5 fish per fisher, and 15 aggregate fish per vessel on a fishing day and prohibit the harvest of species within the surgeonfish FMU (would not apply to a fisher who has a valid commercial fishing license).

Alternative 8. (NEW) Establish an aggregate bag limit for all species in the reef fish FMU of 10 fish per fisher and 30 aggregate fish per vessel, including not more than 2 parrotfish per person or 6 parrotfish per vessel, on a fishing day and prohibit the harvest of species within the surgeonfish FMU (would not apply to a fisher who has a valid commercial fishing license).
